

Schedule II Medications

The following are some of the Schedule II medications that TCN may use:

Adderall
Adderall XR
Concerta
Daytrana Patch

Metadate CD and Metadate ER
Methylin
Procentra
Ritalin and Ritalin LA

Dexdrine
Focalin and Focalin XR

Stratera
Vyvanse

Due to these medications and others being a Controlled Substance-Schedule II, the prescriptions must be picked up or mailed to you. They cannot be called or faxed into the pharmacy. Once the prescription is written you will have 21 days to have it filled. If it should expire, the prescription will need to be rewritten. Refill requests can take up to 48 hours to process, please plan accordingly. There is a \$10.00 charge for C2 refill requests outside of an office visit. You may wish to use a mail order pharmacy through your insurance which will allow you to receive a 30day and 90day supply, giving you four months of medication.

Note: Most all of ADD/ADHD medications are Schedule II.

Schedule II is also referred to as C2 or a Triplicate. They are all Controlled Substances.
